Thank you guys for all the support you have given me over these past years with the sponsorship of my tyres. Your assistant's has been very valuable in helping me achieve my goals in Cadet kart racing. I have won many races and have competed at the front of the field in Tasmania and my 2 trips to Victoria.

We finished my final Cadet class race with 4 wins from 4 starts winning the final by 17 seconds, The final was held under lights at the Smithton track, it had just rained and was very cold was pretty cool racing at night!

We spent a couple of weekends practicing before my first club day as a Rookie and with the help of Jackson Evans from JGE Kart Tuning (New Tassie HAASE agent) we felt pretty confident that we were going to be on the pace.

There was one other rookie at the club day and he had been the quickest at the previous meeting, We got 3 x 2nd places finishing right behind him and beat him in the final. We found out he had new tyres on from his last meeting and we were running our tyres from the state series and all our practice so we were pretty happy.

Our first open race meet was the Rising Stars meeting at Orielton A meeting close to Dad as it is the Ian Harrington (Owner of Roadways Racing) Memorial meeting, we are close friends with his family.

The races are important but the Rising Star is a judged event over all junior classes – I have come 2^{nd} in the last 2 so was hoping to go one step up.

All grids were drawn from computer we started on pole for my first Rookie race, copped a bad start but got back into the lead to get my first win!

Race 2 saw me out of 6th, was 2 by the third corner but coming out of Muskets corner the Kart died! A wire had dragged on the ground and wore through and cut the engine out – Dad took the blame for that one.

Race 3 was wet, started out of 4 and finished 2nd. The rest of the day was wet

Race 4 started out of 3 and finished 4^{th} – we tried a different set up that wasn't quite as good Race 5 started out of 4 and finished 2^{nd}

Final started out of 3 and finished 2nd – Jackson Callow who beat us has won the last 3 race meetings in Rookies.

We were judged to be 3rd in the score for the Rising Stars so was very happy with that.

I am part of Team Hasse Australia and the Tasmanian dealership for Haase Karts has now moved forward and we are receiving full assistance from new dealer Jackson Evans (JGE Kart Tuning) Jackson is a 21 year old karter and has been racing since he was 7 years old, his family has been involved in karting for over 30 years and we look forward to gaining lots from his help.

We are going to miss the City of Melbourne Titles this year to concentrate on some more practice before we head to the Junior Sprint Classic at Pukapunyal in September. The best of Australian Karters go to this meet as it is classed as being the Australian titles for Rookies and Cadets
